Other New Buisness

- Discuss possible use of \$5000 City of Redmond Neighborhood matching grant program to address issues at the park
 - o Notes: Angela investigated a Rainbow play unit to replace current structure at the park. It would cost between \$5000-\$8000 thousand dollars and would need to be maintained for \$800 a year, but would need to be replaced every 10 years. We also talked about metal/plastic options... what about Trex (plastic composite), is wood the best option? Homeowners would like to be involved in determining material and will create a sub committee.
 - New Motion: Pending Reserve Study Funding Spend up to \$7000 from our current reserve to pay for park improvements (which could also be combined with vacant lot improvement below as far as matching up to \$5000 from city, goal is to maximize the grant)

Vote For: 21Vote Against: 0

- Vacant Greenbelt Lot (hilly part, not part of green belt)
 - Notes: Started out overgrown, lots of blackberry, caused a lot of mice and rats problems for neighboring houses. Neighbors planted grass to control weeds/erosion and currently rotate mowing it in the summer. Unsure if it is supposed to be green belt, or maintained. Options include maintained by Double Eagle, or return it to a naturally maintained state. Homeowners are interested in helping/work party to support this clean up.
 - New Motion: Explore expense to return it to natural state, up to \$1000 for this year.

- Discuss the results of the recent traffic study on 167th and consider petition for speed humps
 - Notes: City claims that outliers are in normal range. We feel the trackers were not located in the right location as associated with the park. Corey would like to do a 3 minute petition at the next city council meeting.
- Open the floor
 - Notes: Reserve study, it may be required by law, to determine how much money needs to be held in reserve for the HOA. A study is required every three years, and money must be put aside to cover 30 year asset value/liability.
 - New Motion: Pay for Reserve Study
